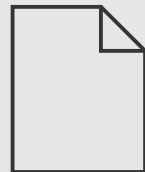

Your central location for working with files

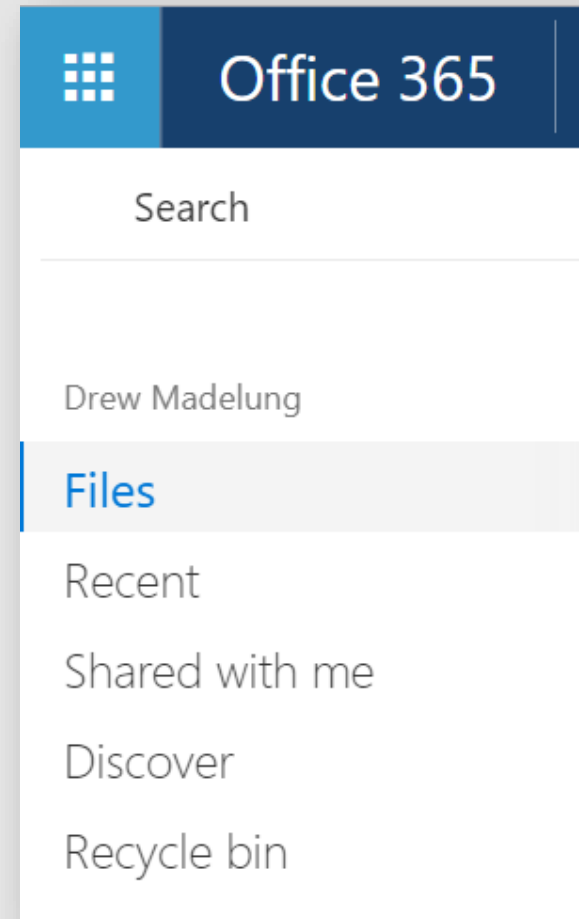

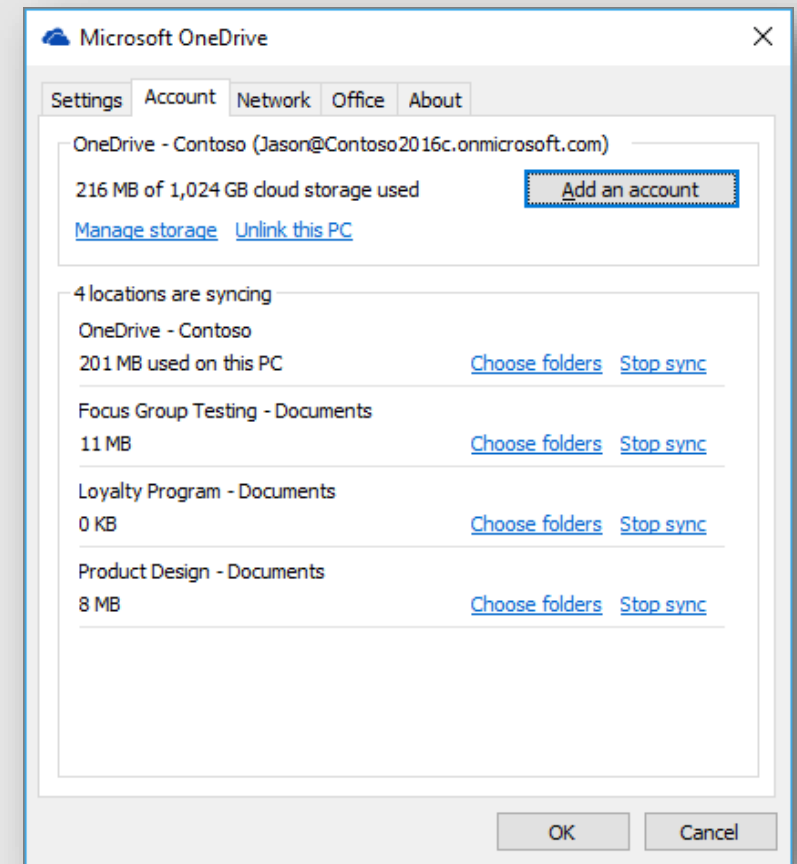
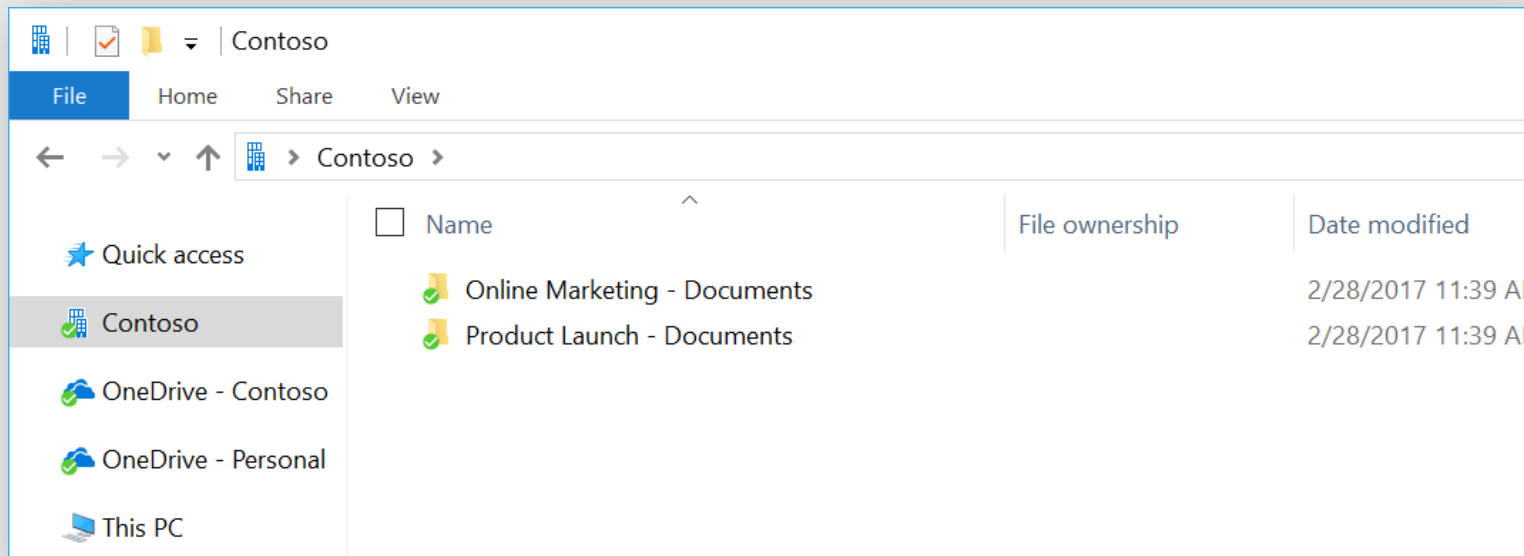
Sync

Copying files between OneDrive & SharePoint

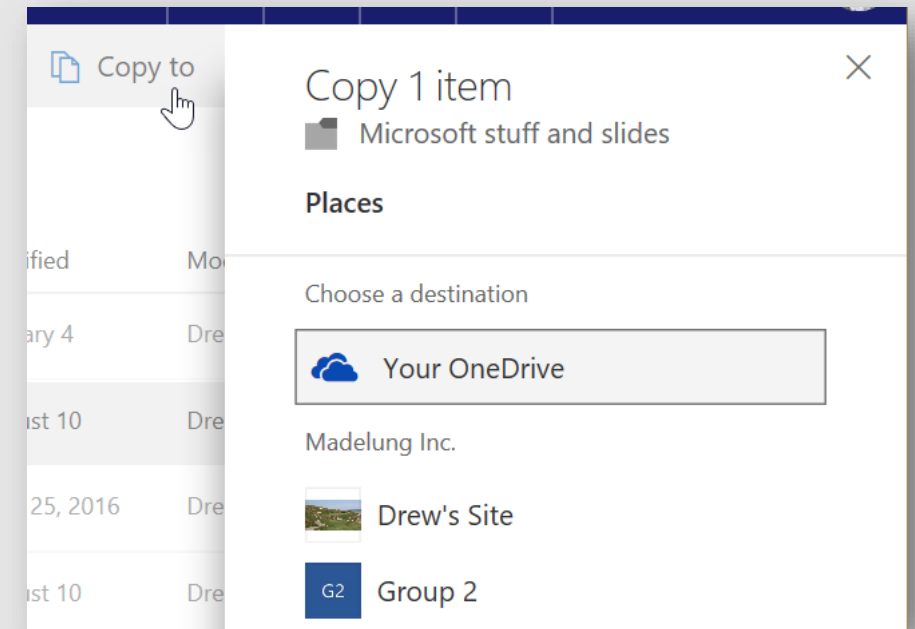
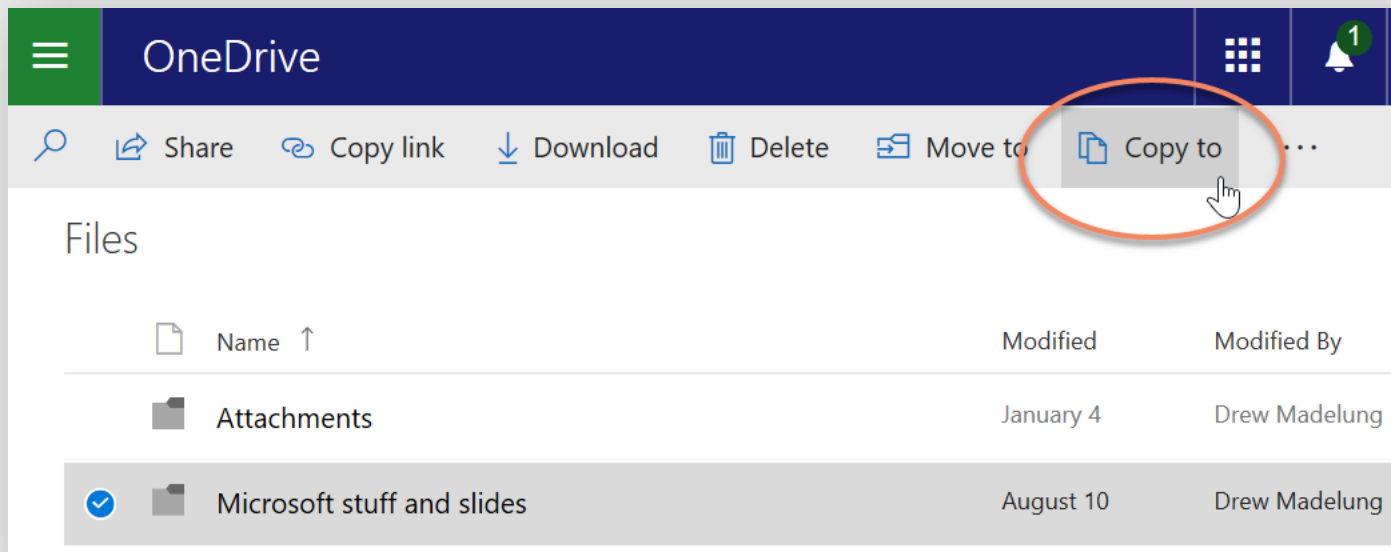
